ICEF will promote and invite all agents to apply to attend FAMIL tours. Further selection process details will be advised to FAMIL tour organisers as the event approaches.

FAMIL tours may only be offered **outside ANZA workshop related activities and times**

FAMIL tour guidelines

- **IMPORTANT NOTE:** Only schools attending the ANZA Workshop 2012 can meet and host agents who have joined ANZA related FAMIL tours. Otherwise non-registered schools could potentially access, and benefit from, agents that ANZA workshop registered schools have helped fund to visit this region. It is the ANZA workshop and its participants who are drawing the agents to this region at this time. FAMIL tour organisers who allow non-registered institutions to meet and host agents while on ANZA approved FAMIL tours will not be invited to offer ANZA FAMIL tours in subsequent years.
- The workshop organisers (ICEF & EdMedia) will not totally control and administer FAMIL tours, but will become sufficiently involved in the promotion of all tours, in order to ensure a “**level playing field**” for all event participants.
- All FAMIL tour proposals are subject to approval and acceptance by the workshop organisers. Non-approved FAMIL tours may not be promoted to ANZA workshop registered agents.
- FAMIL tour organisers may determine all logistics, conditions and costs associated with their FAMIL tour, including which agents are accepted to join, and which are not.
