ICEF Africa returned this year as a hybrid networking event focused on the needs of international education institutions and relevant service providers, all interested in recruiting students from this dynamic and vibrant continent.

291 participants from **49** countries attended this year's event. For **218** delegates, it was an opportunity to network and catch up with old friends in person at the Westin Cape Town Hotel, while **73** joined online.

Together, over the course of three days, they held a total of **2,463** in-person and virtual meetings.

Of the **118** educators at ICEF Africa 2023, **100** travelled to Cape Town to attend in person, while **18** joined online. Together they represented **95** education institutions. For **5%** this was their first ICEF event.

Student Recruitment Agents

ICEF Africa was enthusiastically supported by our community of pre-screened agents. A total of **145** representatives from **134** organisations joined us. **92** attended the event in person, while **53** chose the virtual format.

Agents represented **28** African countries, with the top 5 being: Nigeria (**41%**), Ghana (**6%**), Kenya (**6%**), Uganda (**6%**), and Côte d'Ivoire (**5%**).

All attending agents were pre-screened by ICEF to ensure professional quality, and - as is customary for ICEF events - the majority, **66**%, held a senior management position.
