Increasing student recruitment from the Middle East and North Africa

ICEF Dubai 2024 successfully gathered **573** international education professionals representing **399** organisations for a three-day event. With participants attending from **36** countries across **6** continents, ICEF Dubai demonstrated the continued growth of the MENA region as a key student sending market.

Collectively, attendees held **5,341** pre-scheduled 1:1 meetings at the 5-star Jumeirah Emirates Towers hotel.

Student Recruitment Agents

ICEF Dubai was enthusiastically supported by our community of pre-screened agents - a total of **234** representatives from **199** organisations joined us.

The majority of the agents were from Saudi Arabia (25%), and the UAE (19%), followed by Egypt (11%), Iran (8%), and Morocco (7%).

For **15%** of the agents, ICEF Dubai 2024 was their first event.
