
The ICEF Japan-Korea Roadshow successfully gathered **298 international education professionals** representing **198 organisations** from **19 countries across 5 continents**.

A three-day trip, with a focus on recruiting students from Japan and Korea, the Roadshow saw a total of **1,365 meetings** held at the Keio Plaza Hotel in Tokyo and the Lotte Hotel in Seoul.

With growth in both participant and organisation numbers compared to last year's event, it proved to be a productive and successful Roadshow.

Education Providers

A total of **87 education providers** representing **59 institutions from 17 countries**, joined the ICEF Japan-Korea Roadshow.

The majority came from the US (24%), Canada (22%), Australia (10%), the UK (10%), and Germany (7%), followed by Spain, UAE, China, France, Malaysia, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Saudi Arabia, South Korea, Thailand, and Vietnam.

94% of attendees had previously attended an ICEF event, demonstrating the quality and appeal of our events.

Service Providers

The ICEF Japan-Korea Roadshow welcomed **12 representatives from 6 organisations** from Australia, Japan, Thailand, and the UK.

75% of those attending were in **top management**, reflecting the importance of the event.



Student Recruitment Agents

The first part of the roadshow was held at the Keio Plaza Hotel in Tokyo where 88 Japanese representatives from 64 organisations joined us.

The second portion was at the Lotte Hotel in Seoul where we were joined by **96 Korean agents** from **74 organisations**.

At this year's roadshow, 18% of Korean agents were first-timers, with 25% of Japanese agents making their roadshow debut.



Great Delegate Feedback

Over the course of its 30-year history, ICEF has become renowned for the outstanding organisation of its events. We are always working to ensure that delegates are provided with the best environment, facilities, and support in order to facilitate efficient and productive meetings.

In the after-event survey for the ICEF Japan-Korea Roadshow, the organisation of the event was rated as good or excellent by 91% of respondents, as was the support and level of communication provided by the ICEF team. This feedback demonstrates our ongoing commitment to ensuring each ICEF event is the best it can be.

83% rated the number of new contacts they made as good or excellent, and 82% gave the same rating for the quality of the new contacts.

For 50% of the attendees, this was their first ICEF event, and we look forward to welcoming them back in the future.
